NURSING HOMES ACT 1988—REGULATION

(Relating to fees)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 29th January, 1993.

Amendment

2. The Nursing Homes Regulation 1990 is amended by omitting from clause 5 (b) the matter “\$555” and by inserting instead the matter “\$525”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 5 (2) of the Nursing Homes Act 1988 provides that an application for a licence for a nursing home is to be accompanied by such application fee as may be prescribed by the regulations.

The object of this Regulation is to amend clause 5 (b) of the Nursing Homes Regulation 1990 to decrease the application fee for a nursing home from \$555 to \$525.
