**PRIVATE HOSPITALS AND DAY PROCEDURE CENTRES
ACT 1988—REGULATION**

(Relating to fees)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 29th January, 1993.

Amendment

2. The Private Hospitals Regulation 1990 is amended by omitting from clause 6 (b) the matter “\$555” and by inserting instead the matter “\$525”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 8 (2) of the Private Hospitals and Day Procedure Centres Act 1988 provides that an application for a licence for a private hospital or a day procedure centre is to be accompanied by such application fee as may be prescribed by the regulations.

The object of this Regulation is to amend clause 6 (b) of the Private Hospitals Regulation 1990 to decrease the application fee for a licence for a private hospital from \$555 to \$525.
