CHARITABLE FUNDRAISING ACT 1991—REGULATION

(Relating to the Buddhist Council of NSW Inc.)

HIS Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the Charitable Fundraising Act 1991, has been pleased to make the Regulation set forth hereunder.

The Charitable Fundraising Regulation 1993 is amended by omitting clause 5 and by inserting instead the following clause:

Religious organisations exempt from Act

5. For the purposes of section 7 (1) (b) of the Act, the following are prescribed as religious bodies or religious organisations to which the Act does not apply:

Buddhist Council of New South Wales Incorporated
NSW Auxiliary of the British and Foreign Bible Society

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to exempt the Buddhist Council of New South Wales Incorporated from the application of the Charitable Fundraising Act 1991 (apart from section 48 (enumeration of board members of charitable organisations)). In particular, the Buddhist Council will be exempt from the requirement to obtain an authority under the Act before conducting a fundraising appeal for a charitable purpose.

This Regulation is made under the Charitable Fundraising Act 1991, including section 7 (1) (b).
