I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the Health Care Complaints Act 1993, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 4 May 1994 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) Parts 1, 4, 5 and 7;
- (b) Schedule 3, but only in so far as it amends the Public Sector Management Act 1988;
- (c) Schedule 4.
