EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the amendments to the Justices Act 1902 in the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1993. The amendments:

- (a) enable penalty notices issued under section 24 of the Centennial Park and Moore Park Trust Act 1983 to be brought within the Self-Enforcing Infringement Notice Scheme; and
- (b) allow the use of prescribed short descriptions of indictable offences that may be dealt with summarily in informations, complaints, summonses, warrants, notices, orders and other documents relating to such offences.
