EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the Legal Profession Reform Act 1993 on 1 July 1994. The following provisions have already commenced:

- (a) Schedule 4 (12) (a) (which amended Schedule 8 of the Legal Profession Act 1987 to enable savings and transitional regulations to be made consequent on the enactment of the Reform Act and commenced on 15 April 1994);
