EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the Liquor (Amendment) Act 1994, except for the following provisions of that Act:

- amendments to the Liquor Act 1982 relating to caterers' licences, grant of licences to bodies corporate and penalty notices
 - an amendment to the Justices Act 1902 bringing penalty notices issued under the Liquor Act 1982 within the enforcement scheme of the Justices Act 1902
 - an amendment to the Liquor Regulation 1983.
