1. This Order may be cited as the Government Pricing Tribunal (Council Services) Order 1994.

Declaration of government monopoly services

2. The following services are declared to be government monopoly services:

- (a) water supply services provided by a council (within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1993);

- (b) sewerage services provided by a council (within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1993);
- (c) drainage services provided by a council (within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1993).
