(Relating to fees)

The Maritime Services Board of New South Wales, in pursuance of the Maritime Services Act 1935, hereby makes the following Regulation:

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 1 September 1994.

Amendment

2. The Water Traffic Regulations—N.S.W. are amended by omitting from the Regulation specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this clause the matter specified opposite that Regulation in Column 2 of that Schedule and by inserting instead the matter specified opposite that Regulation in Column 3 of that Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to amend the Water Traffic Regulations—N.S.W. to increase:

- (a) certain fees for an aquatic licence; and
- (b) the fee for the registration of a registrable vessel; and
- (c) the fee for the issue, renewal or replacement of trade plates; and
- (d) certain fees for a general or commercial licence to navigate at speed.

This Regulation is made under the Maritime Services Act 1935, including section 38 (the general regulation-making power, in particular, section 38 (3) (b)).
