SUPERANNUATION ACT 1916—REGULATION

(Relating to the transfer of superannuation benefits of certain former Government
Cleaning Service employees)

and in pursuance of the Superannuation Act 1916, has been pleased to
make the Regulation set forth hereunder..

The Superannuation (Government Cleaning Service Employees
Transfer) Regulation 1994 is amended:

(a) by omitting from clause 4 (2) the words “under clause 5” where
firstly occurring;

(b) by inserting after clause 4 (2) the following subclause:

(2A) Despite subclause (1) (c), a contributor may nominate a
superannuation fund for the purposes of subclause (1) (c) on or
after 12 August 1994 but not later than 30 June 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to extend the last date before which certain former contributors to the State Superannuation Fund, whose employment has been transferred from the Government Cleaning Service, a business unit of the Commercial Services Group, to Berkeley Challenge Australia Pty Limited, Menzies Property Services Pty Limited or Tempo Services Pty Limited in consequence of a Government initiative, may nominate a superannuation fund for the transfer of their preserved superannuation benefits in the State Superannuation Fund. The new date by which a fund must be nominated is 30 June 1995.

The Regulation also makes a law revision amendment to remove unnecessary words.
