I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 5 (1) of the Dairy Industry Act 1979, do, by this my Proclamation, amend Schedule 1 to that Act, with effect on and from 11 February 1994, by adding to that Schedule below the words “Diet White” the following matter:

DYNOMITE (plain or flavoured)
HI-LITE
