EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the remaining provisions of the Lotteries and Art Unions (Amendment) Act 1994 which were not commenced on 1 July 1994. These provisions relate to the following:

- the conduct of lotteries and games of chance by certain charitable and non-profit organisations (Schedule 1 (2), (8) and (9));
- the conduct of lotteries and games of chance where alcohol is offered as a prize (Schedule 1 (3) (c), (4), (5) (c) and (6) (to the extent item (6) relates to section 18B));
- art unions (Schedule 1(15)–(20))
