EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence that part of the Prisons (Amendment) Act 1988 which inserts section 50 (1) (d3) in the Prisons Act 1952. That provision will enable regulations to be made with respect to the expenditure of money within prisons and prison complexes by prisoners.
