The Justices (Short Descriptions of Miscellaneous Offences) Regulation 1993 is mended by inserting at the end of Schedule 1 the following matter:

**Offences under the Water
Board (Water Restrictions)
Regulation 1994**

Clause 2—use water contrary to a breach water restrictions notice under the Regulation

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe a short description of an offence relating to the breach of water restrictions imposed under the Water Board (Water Restrictions) Regulation 1994.

The Regulation is made under sections 145B and 154 of the Justices Act 1902.
