Forms

1. The amendments made hereunder have effect on and from 1 January 1995.
2. In pursuance of Part 47, Rule 2 (2) of the District Court Rules 1973, I have amended the Forms approved for use in the Court as under:

(a) Forms 59, 59B

After “arrested.” insert “If there is a dispute over the amount of your reasonable expenses you may apply to the Court for a decision on what is reasonable, but you must still comply with the subpoena.”

(b) Forms 60, 61

Omit “arrested, and”, insert instead “arrested. If there is a dispute over the amount of your reasonable expenses you may apply to the Court for a decision on what is reasonable, but you must still comply with the subpoena.”
