EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the amendments to the Building Services Corporation Act 1989 and the Consumer Claims Tribunals Act 1987 contained in the Building Services Corporation (Amendment) Act 1994 except those relating to rectification orders. The amendments that are to commence relate to the appointment of building dispute referees, complaints, discipline, insurance, the reconstitution of the Building Services Corporation as a memberless corporation, the creation of the Home Building Advisory Council and savings and transitional provisions.
