Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 3 January 1995.

Amendments

2. Part 2 of the Local Courts (Civil Claims) Rules 1988 is amended by omitting item 9 of rule 2 (5) and by inserting instead the following items:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe a fee for service of a statement of claim in accordance with proposed Part 7 rule 20 of the Local Courts (Civil Claims) Rules 1988. The fee is prescribed by amendment to those Rules (which, in so far as they prescribe fees, are taken by virtue of section 10F (2) of the Local Courts (Civil Claims) Act 1970 to be regulations made by the Governor).

This Regulation is made under section 85 (Regulations—court fees) of the Local Courts (Civil Claims) Act 1970.
