EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence all provisions of the Prisons (Amendment) Act 1993 except certain savings and transitional provisions in Schedules 1 (4), 2 (3) and 4 (16) relating to the Serious Offenders Review Board, the segregation of prisoners, Official Visitors and the management of prisons under submanagement agreements that commenced on assent.
