**PARLIAMENTARY REMUNERATION ACT 1989—
REGULATION**

(To reduce the Premier's remuneration by \$15,000 per annum)

HIS Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989, has been pleased to make the Regulation set forth hereunder.

Amendment

1. Schedule 1 to the Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989 is amended by inserting in Part 1 in the matter relating to the Premier after the matter “55%” the words “less such percentage as is necessary to reduce the Premier's expense allowance by \$15,000”.

Application of amendment

2. The amendment made by this Regulation applies to persons taking office as Premier in or after April 1995, and extends to the expense allowance payable to the Hon. R.J. Carr, Premier, for April 1995, as well as for each future period.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to reduce the Premier's remuneration under the Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989 by \$15,000 per annum. The reduction is made to the amount of the Premier's expense allowance and it applies to remuneration to which the Premier is entitled as from 4 April 1995.

The Regulation is made under sections 6 (4) and 21 of the Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989.
