The Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Investment Powers Regulation 1990 is amended:

- (a) by omitting from Schedule 2 the words “University of Newcastle”;
- (b) by inserting in Schedule 4, in alphabetical order, the following words:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to confer on the University of Newcastle the unlimited power of investment described in Part 4 of Schedule 4 to the Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987. Currently, the University of Newcastle may only exercise the limited powers of investment described in Part 2 of that Schedule.

This Regulation is made under the Public Authorities (Financial Arrangements) Act 1987, including section 24.
