(Relating to fees in connection with certificates of competency)

The Maritime Services Board of New South Wales, in pursuance of the Commercial Vessels Act 1979, hereby makes the following Regulation:

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 30 June 1995.

Amendment

2. The Commercial Vessels (Certificates of Competency and Safety Manning) Regulation 1986 is amended by omitting Schedule 3 and by inserting instead the following Schedule:
