**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Proclamation is to commence item [5] of Schedule 1 to the Local Government Legislation Amendment Act 1995, that is, the amendment to section 283 (Double candidature) of the Local Government Act 1993 that clarifies the procedure to be followed when a successful candidate for popular election as mayor is also a candidate for election as a councillor.
