* Section 2 (Commencement) of the Olympic Co-ordination Act 1995 No. 10 was amended by the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (No. 2) 1995 No. 99, Sch. 2.12, confirming the commencement of the Act on 30.6.96. A proclamation originally published in Gazette No. 90 of 21.7.95, p. 3861 (1995—No.311), appointed 30.6.95 as the date of commencement. However that proclamation was not published until 21.7.95 and pursuant to sec. 23 (5) of the Interpretation Act 1987, the proclamation did not fail merely because it was not published until after the day appointed in the proclamation, but sec. 23 (5) provides, in that event, for the Act to commence on the day on which the proclamation was published in the Gazette.
