The Navigation (Court of Marine Inquiry—Assessors) Rules—N.S.W. are amended by omitting Rule 7 (b).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Rule is to omit a provision of the Navigation (Court of Marine Inquiry—Assessors) Rules—N.S.W. that is obsolete because of the dissolution of the Maritime Services Board on 1 July 1995 (by the Ports Corporatisation and Waterways Management Act 1995).
