**TRAFFIC ACT 1909—REGULATION**

(Relating to the provision of child restraints in taxis)

**Commencement**

**1.** This Regulation commences on 10 February 1995.

**Amendment**

**2.** The Motor Traffic Regulations 1935 are amended by inserting after Regulation 110GA (2) (b) the following matter:

(c) a vehicle being operated as a taxi-cab under the authority of a licence under the Passenger Transport Act 1990.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The object of this Regulation is to reinstate a pre-existing exemption for taxi-cabs from the requirement to provide child-restraints for children under 1 year of age.

This Regulation is made under section 3 (and in particular section 3 (1) (a) and (g)) of the Traffic Act 1909.
