Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Government Pricing Tribunal (Water Services) Order 1995.

Declaration of government monopoly services

2. Any service provided by the Water Administration Ministerial Corporation, to the extent that the service involves:

- (a) the making available of water; or
- (b) the making available of the Corporation's water supply facilities; or
- (c) the supplying of water, whether by means of the Corporation's water supply facilities or otherwise,

is declared to be a government monopoly service.
