**IRRIGATION CORPORATIONS ACT 1994 No. 41—
PROCLAMATION**

I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 (1) of the Irrigation Corporations Act 1994 do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 24 February 1995 as the day on which the following provisions of Schedule 3 to that Act commence:

- (a) items (1) (a) and (c), (3) and (4) of the provisions relating to the Crown Lands Act 1989;
- (b) items (1), (3), (4), (5), (8) (b) and (c) and (9) of the provisions relating to the Crown Lands (Continued Tenures) Act 1989;
- (c) item (1) of the provisions relating to the Irrigation Act 1912;
- (d) the provisions relating to the Mining Act 1992;
- (e) the provisions relating to the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974;
- (f) the provisions relating to the Real Property Act 1900.
