**ANGLICAN CHURCH OF AUSTRALIA (BODIES
CORPORATE) ACT 1938—ORDER**

(Relating to All Saints' College, Bathurst)

I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 4 (3) of the Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938, do, by this my Order, declare that the persons who for the time being are the members of the Council of All Saints' College, Bathurst, constituted under the All Saints' College Bathurst Ordinance 1982–1990 of the Diocese of Bathurst shall be a body corporate under the name “All Saints' College Bathurst Council”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Section 4 of the Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938 provides that the persons who, for the time being, are the members of an unincorporated body that is constituted by an ordinance of the Synod of a diocese for the purpose of managing, governing or controlling an institution or organisation of the Anglican Church of Australia, or of dealing with any church trust property, may be the subject of another ordinance by that Synod declaring that it would be expedient to constitute them as a body corporate.

Once the second ordinance is passed by the Synod, the Governor may, by order published in the Gazette, declare the members of the unincorporated body to be a body corporate.

The purpose of this Order is to provide for the members of the Council of All Saints' College, Bathurst, to be a body corporate known as "All Saints' College Bathurst Council". The relevant ordinance is the All Saints' College Bathurst Ordinance 1982–1990 of the Diocese of Bathurst.
