EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence provisions of the Children (Parental Responsibility) Act 1994 relating to the giving of undertakings, counselling and court attendance and the powers of police to remove children from public places and take them to their parents' residences or care residences or to prescribed places of refuge. The remaining provisions of the Act commenced on 23 December 1994.
