I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the Waste Minimisation and Management Act 1995, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 19 January 1996 as the day on which that Act (other than the following provisions) commences:

- (a) sections 44–47 and 49–62;
- (b) sections 72 and 90;
- (c) Schedule 6.2 [1];
- (d) Schedule 6.9 [1], [3]–[8], [11], [12], [14], [15], [23] and [24].
