Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase from \$274 to \$281 the maximum amount of the minimum ordinary rate that a council may, without special Ministerial approval, make under section 548 of the *Local Government Act 1993*. This Regulation commences on 1 July 1996.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including section 548, particularly section 548 (3) (a), section 748 (the general-regulation making power) and item 20 of Schedule 6 to the Act.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Local Government (Rates and Charges) Amendment Regulation 1996*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 1 July 1996.

4 Amendment of clause 6A of Local Government (Rates and Charges) Regulation 1993

Clause 6A of the *Local Government (Rates and Charges) Regulation 1993* is amended by omitting the matter “\$274” and by inserting instead the matter “\$281”.
