CONSTRUCTION SAFETY ACT 1912—REGULATION

(Repealing obsolete provisions with respect to noise levels)

Commencement

1. This Regulation commences on 31 May 1997.

Amendment

2. The Construction Safety Regulations 1950 are amended by omitting Part 12C.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Regulation is to repeal obsolete provisions with respect to noise levels in places of work as a consequence of the making of the Occupational Health and Safety (Noise) Regulation 1996.

This Regulation is made under the Construction Safety Act 1912, including section 22 (the general regulation making power).
