**POLICE LEGISLATION AMENDMENT ACT 1996—
PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.) G. SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the Police Legislation Amendment Act 1996, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 July 1996 as the day on which that Act commences, except for the following provisions:

- (a) section 4,
- (b) Schedule 1 [1]–[6] and [8]–[13],
- (c) Schedule 2,
- (d) Schedule 6.1, 6.3, 6.5 and 6.7.
