Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to update a reference in the *Justices (Short Description of Fisheries Offences) Regulation 1995* to an offence relating to the sale of eastern rock lobster, as a consequence of a re-arrangement of the offence provisions in the *Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 1995*, and
- (b) to repeal the *Fisheries (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1985*, as the provisions of that Regulation are obsolete.

This Regulation is made under section 145B of the *Justices Act 1902*.

1 Name of Regulation

Insert after clause 3:

4 Repeal

- (1) The *Fisheries (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1985* is repealed.
- (2) The repeal of a prescribed expression in the repealed Regulation does not affect the validity of any information, complaint, summons, warrant, notice, order or other document in which the expression is used and any such document continues to have effect as if that expression had not been repealed.
- (3) Subclause (2) applies to any information, complaint, summons, warrant, notice, order or other document (whether issued, given or made before or after the repeal) that relates to an offence alleged to have been committed before the repeal.
