Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to include in the fees to be taken in respect of the business of the District Court a levy of 3% on amounts collected by the Sheriff pursuant to writs of execution issued by the District Court. This Regulation (together with a Regulation in respect of Local Court fees) will impose the same levy as the levy presently imposed on amounts collected pursuant to writs issued by the Supreme Court.

This Regulation is made under the *District Court Act 1973*, including section 150 (Regulations: Court fees).
