Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to make clear the additional information required to be included in a council's annual report in respect of the remuneration packages payable to senior staff members employed by the council during the year concerned.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including section 428 and section 748 (the general regulation making power).

Insert instead “comprised in the remuneration package of each senior staff member employed during the year that is to include (but not separately indicate)”.
