Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to enable the Auditor-General, if requested to do so by the Minister for the Environment, to inspect and audit the accounts and records of financial transactions of or relating to the Trustee Committee Fund of the Urban Catchment Management Committees (as established by the Environment Protection Authority).

This Regulation is made under the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*, including sections 44 and 64 (the general regulation making power).
