Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to add the Director of Liquor and Gaming (an officer with regulatory and enforcement functions under the *Liquor Act 1982* and the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*) to the list of persons or authorities to whom information acquired by a person in the exercise of functions under the *Casino Control Act 1992* may be divulged.

This Regulation is made under the *Casino Control Act 1992*, including sections 148 (2) and 170 (the general regulation making power).
