1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Energy Services Corporations Act Amendment (Delta Electricity) Regulation 1996*.

Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the *Energy Services Corporations Act 1995* is amended by omitting the name “First State Power” and by inserting instead the name “Delta Electricity”.
