I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 11 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989, do, by this my Order, postpone from 1 September 1996 to 1 September 1997 the date on which the following statutory rules are repealed by section 10 of that Act:

All regulations under the Commercial Vessels Act 1979 that are in force immediately before 1 September 1996 and that would, but for this Order, be repealed on that date by section 10 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989 (6 regulations)

All regulations under the Trade Measurement Act 1989 that are in force immediately before 1 September 1996 and that would, but for this Order, be repealed on that date by section 10 of the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989 (4 regulations)
