Maritime Services Amendment (Abatement of Noise) Regulation 1996

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to omit certain provisions dealing with the abatement of noise from vessels from the *Management of Waters and Waterside Lands Regulations—N.S.W.* and the *Water Traffic Regulations—N.S.W.* The noise emitted by and from vessels will be regulated under the *Noise Control (Marine Vessels) Regulation 1996*.

This Regulation is made under section 38 of the *Maritime Services Act 1935*.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Maritime Services Amendment (Abatement of Noise) Regulation 1996*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 4 October 1996.

3 Amendment of Management of Waters and Waterside Lands Regulations—N.S.W.

The *Management of Waters and Waterside Land Regulations—N.S.W.* are amended by omitting Division 5 of Part 2.

4 Amendment of Water Traffic Regulations—N.S.W.

The *Water Traffic Regulations—N.S.W.* are amended by omitting Regulation 10.

The explanatory note does not form part of this Regulation.
