EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this Proclamation is to commence a provision of the *Statute Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1996* that amends section 3 (2) (d) of the *Motor Vehicles Taxation Act 1988*.

The *Motor Vehicles Taxation Act 1988* provides for the imposition of motor vehicle tax on the registration of motor vehicles. The Act provides for a lower rate of tax if a motor vehicle is used substantially for private purposes and in the opinion of the Roads and Traffic Authority its use for any other purpose is minimal.

The amendment removes a distinction that prevents certain vehicles (which are used for substantially private purposes) from being treated as private vehicles.
