Explanatory note

Under section 20AI (3) of the *Water Act 1912*, an application for the temporary transfer of a volumetric water allocation may be made so long as the transfer of the water allocation is for a period of not more than 3 years (or some other period prescribed by the regulations). The object of this Regulation is to prescribe 5 years as the maximum period in respect of temporary transfers of water allocations.

This Regulation is made under the *Water Act 1912*, including sections 20AI and 27 (the general regulation making power for the purposes of Part 2 of the Act).
