Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to authorise a roads authority to exempt a person or class of persons from complying with clause 17 and with one or more of the provisions of Division 1 of Part 4 of the *Roads (General) Regulation 1994*, which prohibits certain actions by persons on bridges and governs the action of persons on bridges and approaches to bridges (clause 39).

This Regulation is made under the *Roads Act 1993*, including section 264 (the general regulation making power, in particular section 264 (1) (c)).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Roads (General) (Bridge Exemption) Amendment Regulation 1996*.

This Regulation commences on 1 December 1996.

Schedule 1 Amendments

[1] Clause 17 (2)

Insert at the end of clause 17:

- (2) A roads authority may, either unconditionally or subject to conditions, exempt any person or class of persons in writing from the operation of this clause.

[2] Clause 47A

Insert after clause 47:

47A Exemptions

A roads authority may, either unconditionally or subject to conditions, exempt any person or class of persons in writing from the operation of any provision or provisions of this Division.
