**POLICE LEGISLATION FURTHER AMENDMENT ACT 1996—
PROCLAMATION**

(L.S.) G. SAMUELS, Governor.

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels, AC, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Police Legislation Further Amendment Act 1996*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint:

- (a) 16 December 1996 as the day on which sections 1–4 of that Act, and Schedule 1 [60] to that Act, commence, and
- (b) 1 January 1997 as the day on which the remaining provisions of that Act commence.
