His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council has, made the following Regulation under the *Architects Act 1921*.

### **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to increase from \$82 to \$86 the annual roll fee for architects and the fee to restore an architect's name to the Register of Architects.

This Regulation is made under the *Architects Act 1921*, including section 25 (the general regulation-making power, in particular, section 25 (1) (e)) and section 11.
