Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to describe more specifically certain substances as prohibited drugs in Schedule 1 to the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*. Those substances are currently prohibited as they are analogues of other prohibited drugs specified in that Schedule.

This Regulation is made under section 44 of the *Drug Misuse and Trafficking Act 1985*.
