# **Chiropractors and Osteopaths Amendment Regulation 1996**

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe an additional course of training that is recognised as qualifying a person for registration as a chiropractor in New South Wales and to prescribe a lower fee for restoration of a chiropractor's or osteopath's name to the register.

This Regulation is made under the *Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act 1991*, including sections 9 (a), 18 (6) and 65.
