ELECTRICITY SUPPLY ACT 1995 No 94—PROCLAMATION

I, the Honourable ANTHONY MURRAY GLEESON, AC, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the Electricity Supply Act 1995, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 1 March 1996 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) Part 1;
- (b) Division 2 of Part 7;
- (c) sections 106, 107, 108, 109 and 110;
- (d) Schedules 3 and 4;
- (e) Schedule 5.1 [6];
- (f) so much of Schedule 5.1 [14] as repeals Schedules 8 and 10 to the Electricity Act 1945;
- (g) Schedule 5.1 [15];
- (h) Schedule 5.9;
- (i) Part 1, and Division 2 of Part 2, of Schedule 6;
- (j) the Dictionary.

 - (c) the water supply functions exercised by certain electricity distributors.
