Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the contributions payable by the owners of certain coal mines to the Mines Rescue Board for the year ending on 30 June 1997 (Schedule 1 [3] and [4]).

This Regulation also makes other minor amendments by way of law revision (Schedule 1 [1] and [2]).

This Regulation is made under the *Mines Rescue Act 1994*, including section 50 (the general regulation-making power) and section 31.
